Proposed Severity Scoring System for Active Mpox

NSTRUCTIONS

For each of the 7 variables (rows), score the person's current status for that variable by placing an "X" in that box.

Scoring:

- For each check box, the score for that variable that equals the Grade (example: 10-100 lesions total is Grade 2 and thus lesions would be score as a "2".
- Sum the scores for each row to get a total severity score (should range 1 23) and then enter the value at top of completed form.
